AIM OF THE COURSE

To enhance the current practice of health professionals referring to the wheelchair and seating service for equipment.

#### **OBJECTIVES**

- 1. Understand the theory and principles underlying postural management with particular reference to pelvic stability.

- 3. Demonstrate basic skills in assessing and measuring a person accurately for a piece of equipment.
- 4. Select appropriate wheelchairs and cushions from the accessible range of ALAC equipment to meet service user's needs.
- 5. Appreciate what is standard and non-standard in terms of the person and equipment.
- 6. Recognise when to refer to ALAS for a more specialised assessment.
